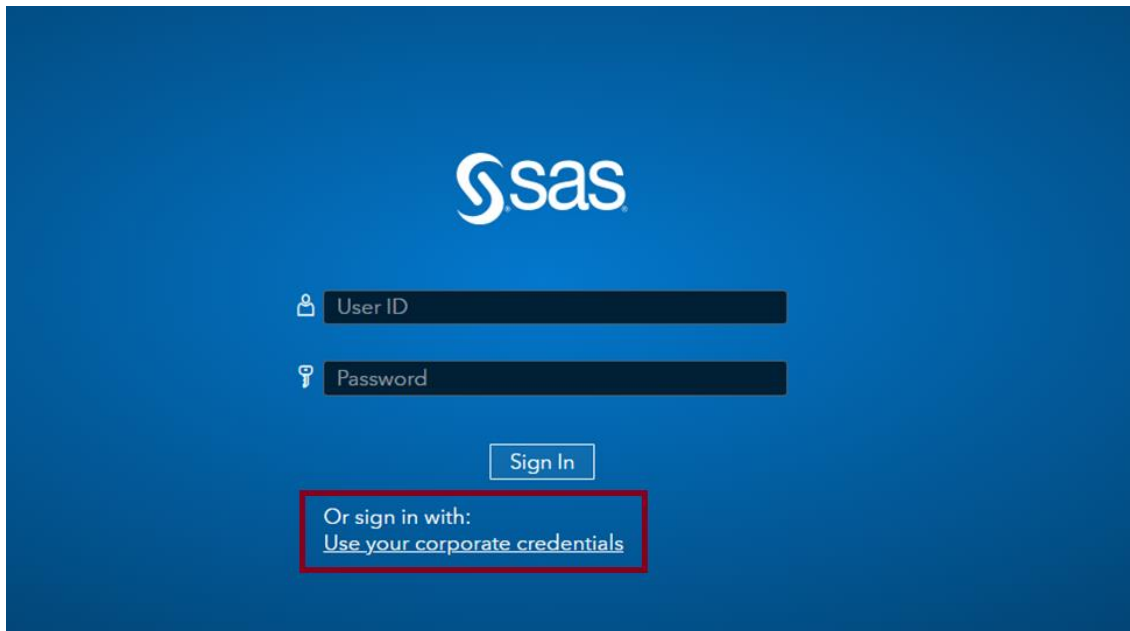




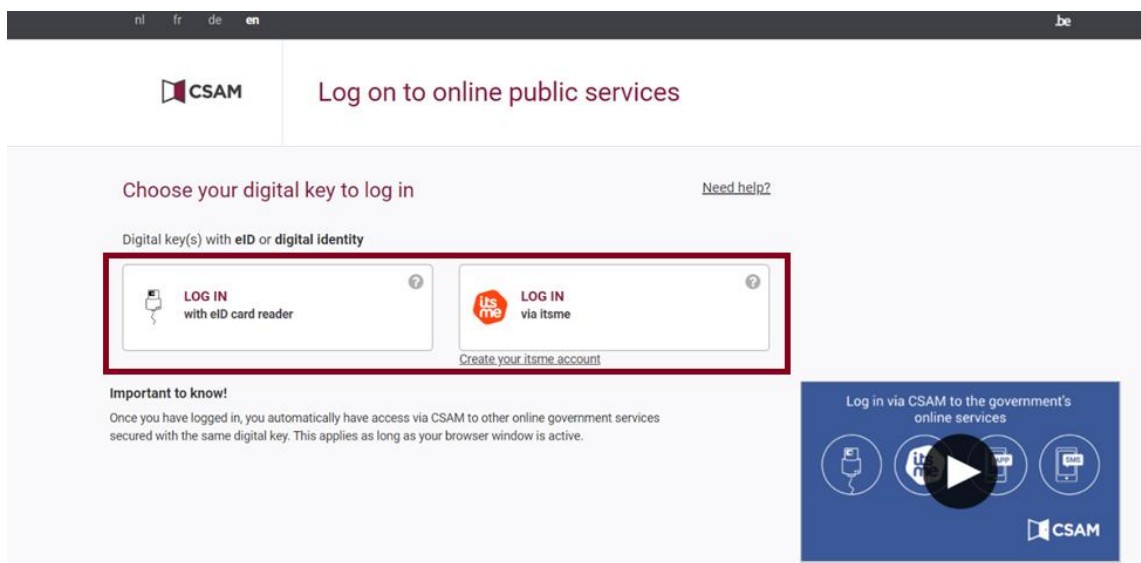
# Dashboard Access

## [eID card reader](#) / [itsme](#)

On the SAS log-in screen, please click the option to log in using your corporate credentials.



This should redirect you to a new screen with two log in options: either with a eID card reader or with itsme (the itsme option requires you to have the itsme app and account, or you can create a new account by clicking the link under the option).





## eID card reader

If you have an eID card reader, you can follow the instructions on the page in order to gain access to your approved dashboards.
